

Water Conservation Intern Position

Full time Seasonal / Temporary Job

The Weber Basin Water Conservancy District is looking for individuals to help patrol the District's service area to educate water users about the watering limitations between 10:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. The position will also require some work in the Water Conservation Learning Garden which will include regular landscape maintenance type work.

Job Summary: Patrols various routes in the Weber Basin service area (Davis and Weber Counties) looking for water users that are watering at incorrect times during the day or wasting water. Door hangers are left at those locations and records are kept as to the location and time of the occurrence. Other work will include landscape maintenance activities on the water conservation learning garden (from 8:00 am.- 10:00 a.m. each day). Some additional work may include assisting other district staff for events or high priority work should the need arise. Work schedule will be Monday through Friday normal business hours with rare Saturdays for special events.

Four positions will be available starting in May. This is a full time, seasonal position typically ending in September.

Job Requirements: No specific experience necessary but knowledge of basic landscape practices and maintenance techniques will be helpful. The candidate must have the following abilities:

- Must have and maintain a valid driver's license and an acceptable driving record per District policy.
- Must be at least 18 years of age.
- Be confident in speaking to the public in what could be confrontational situations. Able to share information with the public in an enthusiastic manner to promote awareness and result in a behavior change.
- Be able to work outdoors in full sun for extended periods.
- Be able to lift 50 pounds.
- Be able to use personal computer with a basic understanding of word processing and basic spreadsheet data entry.
- Be able to work with others in cooperation or alone.

Wage: \$10.00-\$12.00 per hour depending on experience.

Hours: 40 hours per week from May through September. Work hours will be 8:00 a.m- 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday. Occasional Saturday work may be required.
